Trying to Reason...

Here we are, sailing in the Fall and steering toward Key West for Meeting of the Minds! While I will leave the details and phun to come for other articles in the Tradewind Times, this is a great forum to put to

rest why this may be the last year we are in Key West for MOTM. A lot has changed and is coming to fruition in the PHiP organization, and our clubs are growing! Change is never easy, and MOTM is no different. Spelled out, here are a few KEY factors!



- 1. MOTM has moved before (for everyone saying it needs to stay for traditional or historical reasons), since it started in New Orleans.
- 2. We sent out a survey, and we followed the results. A vast majority of our members live in a triangle between Texas, the Carolinas, and Key West.
- 3. Overwhelmingly people wanted to stay in the "Florida/SE" region, near the water, where it is warm, and COST was a huge factor, especially air and hotel rates.
- 4. Next, having the event where things are "walkable" or easily accessible was important AND not overshadowing an area that already hosted a major event.

As you can see, this is no small task. We narrowed the list down according to these parameters and in talking to the local area presidents. Some had WAY too questionable weather. Others simply aren't ready. The team tried every angle to stay in Key West including talking directly to the Chamber of Commerce who were not interested (we are actually a small scale event compared to others).

The Masthead ... A blustery day on the beach, the Trade Winds blowing hard. It's hard to reason with the season, but I must confess, we could use some rest. So relax and enjoy the Tradewind Times.

To reiterate, the Casa is under construction that will literally make the AREA unusable for the event. Neighboring hotels do not have the space nor interest, and some that did are not near Duval at all (even though the hotel prices are lower) and would require increased costs for power, stage, lights, sound, security, etc.

The true facts are, we COULD still be in Key West, and our members may be able to pay the previously expected prices for hotels on the far side of the island, but the need for a lot more transportation and the other events to make this happen cost upwards of \$500 per ticket to start and/or a la carte ticketing (we do not believe our members want to pay an increased price like that).

From this, we will be announcing 2023 and future plans. The committee was made up of club members and Board members who have done an amazing job of trying to reason with all of these cities and venues. Again, change is not easy, but the goal is to make the MOTM convention for ALL OF OUR MEMBERS accessible, affordable and valuable.

MOTM Bids Farewell to Key West

Inflation and the remodeling of the historic Casa Marina have forced what a pandemic and hurricanes could not, the removal of Meeting of the Minds from the iconic Florida key town so steeped in Buffett history. However before that happens, get ready for the biggest Trop Rock music extravaganza ever on

the beachfront stage at the resort built as a monument to the visionary Henry Flagler and opened in 1920.

Once again this year a limited number of onsite registrations will be accepted. In addition to the standard registration fee of \$172.22, there will



be a membership fee for the Virtual Parrot Head Club. The latter is an IRS requirement and eliminates the necessity of confirming active membership of onsite registrants. Everyone registering will be dues paying Parrot Heads, at least virtually. Late registration does not include the event T-shirt or goodie bag.

Blue Chair Bay Rum joins MOTM as a sponsor for the first time, sponsoring the Pier Stage, and presenting the Girls Just Wanna Have Rum Songwriter Showcase, the headlining show on opening night of the 30th gathering of the Parrot Heads in Paradise. Coley McCabe hosts and performs as part of the All-Star female singer-songwriter showcase with Nadirah Shakoor, Erica Sunshine Lee, Heather Vidal, and Claire Wright.

The day begins with Pirates & Poets showcases featuring six great singer-songwriters. Sunny Jim White calls the convention to order with his afternoon performance, followed by a Donny Brewer and Mike Nash-led tribute to the Eagles, featuring many of your favorite trop rockers!

The first full day of music at the 30th Annual Meeting of the Minds includes the return of Gary Roland and the Landsharks, whose legendary 1998 Duval and Greene Street concert at the first Key West MOTM was crashed by Jimmy Buffett himself! The Peter Mayer Group will sing to "Suzannah" while the sun goes down.

Hazelnuts... Meet the Parrot Heads! Florida's own Sister Hazel's most rabid fans call themselves Hazelnuts, and they have their own cruises and beach parties. Their prime time performance is their first at MOTM for the band, rated along with Michael Franti and Mac McAnally as a "must see" live performance by the Margaritaville blog.

As if that weren't enough for one night, Jimmy and the Parrots provide the high energy night cap to send y'all to bed with a smile and some dance sweat!

The early Saturday schedule includes the Parrot Heads in Paradise general meeting, a spectacular auction of memorabilia benefitting the Lone Palm Foundation, and a blockbuster finale for Kelly McGuire's Lighthouse Songwriter Showcase that includes a quartet of the top female voices in trop rock - Heather Vidal, Erica Sunshine Lee, Aubrey Wollett and Claire Wright, plus accomplished singer-songwriters Bill Whyte and Jeff Dayton, with an extended finale set from Grammy and CMA winning superstar Kristian Bush.

The final night of the 30th MOTM promises to deliver some magical moments. With five Billboard chart topping albums, Mishka is among the best selling reggae artists of this century. He will be followed by Utley and Greenidge as Club Trini, with the full Coral Reefer Band, featuring John Frinzi. And capping off the night is the highly anticipated arrival in Parrot Head Nation of Grammy-winning reggae artist Gramps Morgan. World Music Saturday is presented by MyWorldMeds.com.

MOTM Sunday Schedule at the Casa includes two rounds of Pirates & Poets songwriter showcases, followed by a closing set from Jerry Diaz , joined for some final moments by Scott Nickerson, when the MOTM-founding duo will close the 30th Meeting of the Minds in the same way they began the first in 1992 in New Orleans.

and \$1000 was raised for Lustgarten Foundation for Pancreatic Cancer Research.



Additionally, we celebrated our 30th Anniversary with a cruise around the Great South Bay on the Moonchaser Boat. 90 members and guests enjoyed a beautiful sunset, fantastic entertainment by Barometer Soup (a local Jimmy Buffett cover band) and \$450 was raised for Alzheimer's Association.



Hardy groups of partiers always find ways to provide much needed help to their communities. They are known as Parrot Heads. These are their stories.

On August 15, 5 Central Illinois PHC members volunteered to host a Carnival themed party for the campers at Ann Benjamin Camp! This camp is a week-long overnight camp serving young adults with disabilities.

Phun Coast PHC raised a total of \$5,500 this quarter in a variety of activities to benefit Alzheimer's Association and Grace Community Food Pantry including a Tarot Reading Party which raised \$1,024.

San Antonio PHC collected fans for Project Cool, a Catholic Charities organization that provides fans for elderly residents, school supplies for the North East ISD McKenny Vento program that supports homeless children attending district schools, and presented a \$1,000 check to the Amos Rehabilitation Keep, an organization that takes care of injured birds and sea life.

Jake Bodner, from East Haven, Connecticut (Parrot Head Club of Connecticut) is the winner of the third place award of \$2000.


Again, congratulations to the three winners, and thank you to all that applied as well as our judges who took many hours out of their days to help in making this very tough decision.
